- Provide 2nd line support for installation issues occurring at customer site in collaboration with our Customer Support team.
- The system team supports the development teams in their day to day work by maintaining the infrastructure and tooling they use, by solving operational problems.
- Install, upgrade and tune used tooling.
- Explore new technologies sa Docker, Cloud technologies, Octopus,
