Info and procedure

From those applications that meet the entry requirements, a **first selection** will be made on the basis of artistic portfolio and research abstract, considering criteria of artistic quality, research potential, and complementarity with the profiles of the school of arts and its programmes and departments.

Candidates selected for the **second round** will be appointed a (provisional) supervisor at KASK & Conservatorium in the course of December2021. This supervisor will guide the candidate in the process of completing a full (6-year)project application and selecting a second supervisor at Ghent University.



From these applications, a number of candidates will be selected for the **final interviews**.

The interviews are scheduled for **early May 2022**. Candidates who are not selected will be notified upon completion of the entire procedure.
